VIRGINIA ASPHALT ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP DUES AND FEES

CONTRACTOR MEMBERSHIP

The dues and fees structure for Contractor Members (those firms producing Hot-Plant Mixed Bituminous Concrete or similar materials) has been established by the Board of Directors as required by the Association By-laws. Current Contractor Membership dues and fees are as follows:

- (A) Annual Dues: Annual Dues of \$800 collectable with Membership application, or on January 1st of each subsequent year.
- (B) Tonnage Fees: A six cents per ton fee, collectable monthly, for plant mixed bituminous concrete or any other plant mixed material produced for use on ALL work. (Highway, Private, Municipal, F.O.B. etc.). Report forms are furnished by the Association.

ASSOCIATE CONTRACTOR MEMBERSHIP

The dues structure for Associate Contractor Members (those firms engaged in the planning, milling, profiling or placement of bituminous concrete and not eligible for Contractor Membership) has been established by the Board of Directors as required by the Association By-laws. Current Associate Contractor Membership dues are as follows:

Annual Dues: Amount for each category (listed below) per year collectable with membership application, or on January 1st of each subsequent year.

HAULING CONTRACTORS	\$1,500

AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP

ASSOCIATION OBJECTIVES

In order that those interested will know the purposes of this organization, the following is quoted, in part, from the Certificate of Incorporation and By-laws of the Virginia Asphalt Association, Inc.:

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF THE VIRGINIA ASPHALT ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED

This is to Certify that we hereby associate ourselves to establish a corporation under and by virtue of Chapter 13 of Title 13 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, for the purposes and under the corporate name hereinafter mentioned, and to that end we do, by this our certificate, set forth as follows:

(A) NAME

The name of the corporation is to be Virginia Asphalt Association, Incorporated.

(B) PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the corporation in the State of Virginia is to be located in the City of Richmond.

(C) PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

- (1) To make available and render free information and consulting services to governmental and private bodies interested in paving.
- (2) To disseminate information regarding the economy of paving with plant-mixed asphalt.
- (3) To engage generally in all educational and promotional activities of a type similar to a chamber of commerce or board of trade, or a business league.
- (4) To promote and increase the use of plant-mixed asphalt in paving of highways and streets.
- (5) To promote the common business interests and to promote business conditions for asphalt pavers generally.
- (6) To exercise all powers that shall be deemed necessary or expedient, for the successful accomplishment of the foregoing purposes, and to exercise all incidental powers conferred on similar corporations by general statutes of the Commonwealth.

(D) NON-STOCK CORPORATION

The corporation is not organized for profit and is to have no capital stock. Its operating expenses shall be paid from funds secured from its members as dues or assessments.
