Originally initiated to inform both industry and VDOT employees regarding changes associated with VDOT's Blueprint plan, later seminars morphed into opportunities to share information on a myriad of topics pertaining to what is relevant to the industry or VDOT. With a primary focus on Innovation in the Industry, this year's agenda will include critical topics such as workplace safety, a review of 2017 lessoned learned, an overview of the lab round robin organized by the VAA, new initiatives planned for 2018 and much more. Key VAA, VDOT and Industry personnel will be present to present this valuable information and to address any questions or concerns that you may have.
